

Artist in Residence

Through a mandate with the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC), Pro Helvetia Cape Town enables professional artists from within the Southern African region to spend residencies elsewhere in the region. Artists-in-residence stays can be organised for periods of between three weeks and six months. With this artist-in-residence programme, Pro Helvetia Cape Town is encouraging intercultural exchange in the fields of visual arts.

Southern African cultural practitioners can apply for this residency at the Pro Helvetia Cape Town office. Two to four residencies are granted for each of these regions each year.

Conditions

Artists applying for a residency must have a convincing track record in the arts, be willing to engage with the culture of the host country and have the requisite language skills. Pro Helvetia gives preference to long-term projects that have a sustainable impact and international resonance.

- Insurance
- Costs of board and accommodation
